

## Questions To Ask In An Interview

For each interview, you should prepare some questions before the interview. This not only shows your interest, but also shows you did your homework especially if you ask specific things about the company. Here are some common questions you can ask.

<b>Question 1</b>	What do you think are the most important qualities for someone to excel in this position?
<b>Question 2</b>	Could you walk me through what a typical day is like in this position.? What can be expected?
<b>Question 3</b>	What can be expected of me in the first 30/60/90 days?
<b>Question 4</b>	Could you talk about your company culture and what it is like to work there?
<b>Question 5</b>	Is there a career path for this position? What is the growth potential for this position?
<b>Question 6</b>	What do you like best about your company? Could you tell me one pro, one con, and one thing you would change with the snap of your finger?
<b>Question 7</b>	What are some challenges the company is facing?
<b>Question 8</b>	Do you have any hesitations about my qualifications?
<b>Question 9</b>	What are the next steps?
